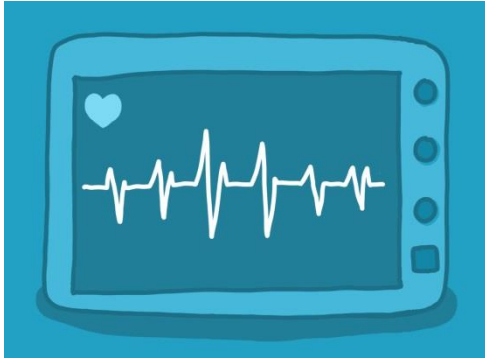


Newborn Monitoring System User Study
